

## SINGAPORE ENVIRONMENTAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS HONOURS GREEN CORPORATE EFFORTS ACROSS INDUSTRIES

**Singapore, 27 August 2019:** Eleven organisations were recognised as stewards of environmental excellence today at the 22<sup>nd</sup> annual Singapore Environmental Achievement Awards (SEAA) held at Pan Pacific Singapore.

A dedicated panel expertly assessed each nomination before finalising the winning organisations. Each submission was evaluated for its commitment to sustainability and environmental excellence. As one of the most prestigious environmental awards in Singapore and the region, the SEAA looks beyond an organisation's green business efforts to make an impact on surrounding communities.

Start-up companies and small-and-medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) are considered as thoroughly as those of larger organisations. Singapore Environment Council (SEC) Executive Director, Ms Jen Teo, said the SEAA identifies and acknowledges commendable achievements that are made on a corporate level, highlighting the pivotal role organisations play in advocating environmental excellence.

“We began the SEAA 22 years ago to recognise organisations with an interest in conserving the environment, and have given out more than 100 awards to organisations for their environmental stewardship,” said Ms Teo. “The SEAA has made tremendous headway in spurring organisations across various industries to embed the environment and sustainability in their business strategy and decision making. Purposeful action by these organisations to be more green in the way they operate can have a ripple effect on their employees and the wider community to help secure a greener and more liveable Singapore for today and future generations.”
